## THE LITTLE RINGING BELL

There is a place in the countryside with a field  
that has two horses in it.

From a distance, each horse looks like any other  
horse. But if you stop your car, or are walking by,

that he is blind. His owner has chosen not to have  
him put down, but has made a good home for him.  
This alone is amazing.

If you stand nearby and listen, you will hear the  
sound of a bell. Looking around for the source  
of the sound, you will see that it comes from  
the smaller horse in the field.

Attached to the horse's halter is a small bell.  
It lets the blind friend know where the other  
horse is, so he can follow.

As you stand and watch these two friends,  
You'll see that the horse with the bell is  
always checking on the blind horse, And that  
the blind horse will listen for the bell and  
then slowly walk to where the other horse is,  
trusting that he will not be led astray.

When the horse with the bell returns to the  
shelter of the barn each evening, it stops  
occasionally and looks back, making sure that  
the blind friend isn't too far behind to hear the  
bell.

Like the owners of these two horses, God does  
not

throw us away just because we are not perfect or  
because we have problems or challenges.

He watches over us and even brings others into  
our lives to help us when we are in need..

Sometimes we are the blind  
horse being guided by the little ringing bell of  
those  
who God places in our lives.

Other times we are the  
guide horse, helping others to find their way....

Good friends are like that... You may not always  
see them, but you know they are always there.

Please listen for my bell and I'll listen for yours.

And remember...  
Be kinder than necessary

Everyone you meet is fighting  
Some kind of battle.

Live simply,  
Love generously,  
Care deeply,  
Speak kindly...

Leave the rest to God.

## “The Family’s Main Ingredient”

The **Infant Jesus**, Son of God, the **Blessed Virgin Mary**, His Mother, and **Saint Joseph**, His foster father constitute the ideal model for every family. They show us that a family does not have to be wealthy or famous in order to be successful. As long as deep affection, caring, patience, respect, selflessness, dedication...in a word, **love**... exist, a family will survive, and *thrive!* But the key is love. It must exist between mother and father, parents and child/children. The source, the center of this love is God, for **God is love** (cf.: **I John 4:16**; *Deus Caritas Est*, encyclical letter of **Pope Benedict XVI**).

When we look at the state of our nation and world today, it’s obvious that the family unit has suffered greatly. Yes, there are still families, *thanks be to God*, which are good, solid, loving. But so many families are broken, or to use contemporary parlance, *dysfunctional*. The ones who suffer most from this situation are the children.

It’s never the ideal for a child to be raised by one parent (usually the father is absent). Sometimes this cannot be helped if one of the parents is widowed. But too often infidelity or divorce is the cause for one-parent households. Unmarried parents are hardly models for their children. They are demonstrating fear of commitment. Children, disillusioned in such conditions, may then be desirous to have a good marriage as adults and bring up their own children in a more stable setting. On the other hand, some children will simply repeat their parents’ mistakes, which could include sexual promiscuity, STDs, unplanned pregnancies, divorce, and worse of all, abortion.

The main cause for the dysfunctional-ness of broken families is lack of faith and religion as a solid foundation. Many unmarried or divorced parents don’t attend church (*although many married parents don’t either!*). So the cycle is perpetuated. If children receive any of the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Penance, Holy Eucharist), sometimes it’s only because the parents view them as “rites of passage,” something “to be done” or “to get.” A child is often brought to religious education, but not to Mass because the parents don’t go. *Ridiculous!* This is a critical misunderstanding of what it means to be a sincere, practicing Catholic. The time for being a “cafeteria Catholic” (i.e., picking and choosing what one likes while discarding the rest) should be over. One must decide to dedicate his/her life to his spouse. A man and woman who exchange vows in holy matrimony welcome Christ as the One Who binds and sustains their marriage. Then, if the married couple is blessed by God with children, they raise them in the faith.

There’s a certain attitude today that says, “I’m a ‘*spiritual*’ person. *Religion isn’t important as long as you care about each other.*” But how many fragmented families *really care* about each other? Aren’t they fragmented precisely because they’re too absorbed in *ME* rather than *THEY*? If one truly cares, then one puts others’ needs first.

It’s not easy to be a family. There will always be struggles. Each family member has to do his/her work. *But it’s not impossible.* The Holy Family faced--and dealt with--many obstacles. How? By their selfless love, **that love which is God**. Unless God is the center of every family, families will continue to disintegrate, and along with them, society.
