## **“A LITTLE HUMOR”**

### **“Cat and Mice in Heaven”**

A cat died and went to Heaven. God met her at the gates and said, “You have been a good cat all these years, anything you want is yours for the asking.” The cat thought for a minute and then said, “All my life I lived on a farm and slept on hard wooden floors. I would like a real fluffy pillow to sleep on.” God said, “Say no more.” Instantly the cat had a huge fluffy pillow.

A few days later, six mice were killed in an accident and they all went to Heaven together. God met the mice at the gates with the same offer that He made to the cat. The mice said, “Well, we have had to run all of our lives from cats, dogs, and even people with brooms! If we could just have some little roller skates, we would not have to run again.” God answered, “It is done.” All the mice had beautiful little roller skates.

About a week later, God decided to check on the cat. He found her sound asleep on her fluffy pillow. God gently awakened the cat and asked, “Is everything okay? How have you been doing? Are you happy?” The cat replied, “Oh, it is WONDERFUL. I have never been so happy in my life. The pillow is so fluffy, and those little meals on wheels you have been sending over are delicious!”



The refrain from the popular Christmas carol, “**O Holy Night**” contains the moving lyrics, “*Fall on your knees, O hear the angels voices!*” which direct all of us who come to adore the newborn Infant Jesus in the manger. The words are also applicable to reverence for Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament in our Catholic churches.

“*Combat!*” was a television drama that ran on ABC from 1962-1967 and centered around a squad of American soldiers in France during World War II. The stars of “*Combat!*” were the late actors Rick Jason (1923-2000) as Lt. Gil Hanley and Vic Morrow (1929-1982) as Sgt. Chip Saunders. Like most series, it’s now available on DVD.

A particularly brief but crucial scene of one episode concerns us here. Sgt. Saunders found himself in a bombed-out Catholic Church in France where he was tracking a Nazi. Unknown to Saunders, the Nazi disguised himself as a priest by donning a cassock. The two men eventually met, and the Nazi nearly got away with his deceit but for one critical flaw. Saunders was standing in the back of the church. He watched the “priest” approach him after emerging from a confessional near the damaged sanctuary. Saunders immediately apprehended his man. The Nazi was stunned. How did Saunders see through his disguise? The American sergeant replied that when the “priest” passed before the main altar and tabernacle to proceed down the aisle, he never stopped to genuflect. No true priest would ever make that mistake, Saunders pointed out.

What a powerful episode, and how it still makes an impression some four decades later! We can learn two important points from that “*Combat!*” episode.

First, rare is the TV show or movie today that treats those parts of Catholicism most precious to us with reverence, respect, and truth! Most media depictions prefer to focus on stereotypes, the sins of some, outright lies, and Catholic bashing in general.

Second, how many Catholics over the previous decades have shown lack of respect, indifference, or blatant unbelief by refusing to genuflect before Our Lord in the Most Holy Eucharist, reserved in the tabernacle! Along with laity, this includes some priest and religious. Barring a physical impediment, why did bending one’s knees suddenly become “old fashioned”? Certainly the movement of the tabernacle to hidden spaces or even outside the body of the typical parish church contributed to the disrespect. Thanks to **Popes John Paul II** (*Ecclesia de Eucharistia*, 2003, *Redemptionis Sacramentum*, 2004) and **Benedict XVI** (*Sacramentum Caritatis*, 2007), we are beginning to see a return to the tabernacle to the central place of prominence that it deserves, after the ill-advised experimentation and moves of the early post-Vatican II years. This is accompanied by a renewal of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the Forty Hours Devotion. (See: [www.Vatican.va](http://www.Vatican.va) for document texts.)

Pope Benedict writes in the document cited above: “***The correct positioning of the tabernacle contributes to the recognition of Christ’s real presence in the Blessed Sacrament.***” (#69) Unlike the imposter Nazi priest in “*Combat!*” may we always demonstrate our awareness and reverence for Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. Our actions will only enhance our and others’ belief in this awesome mystery of our faith.
