**HAPPY 100<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY!** – February 7th is Boy Scout Sunday and kicks off the celebration of the 100th Birthday of Boy Scouts in America. On February 8, 1910 Chicago publisher William Dickson Boyce filed incorporation papers in the District of Columbia to create the Boy Scouts of America. Cub Scouts and Boy Scouts offer a tremendously valuable program of life skills and values for millions of boys. At the 9:30 Mass we will have scouts from area troops participating in Mass as altar servers, giving the sign of peace, and recognizing scouts who have earned their religious medals. The U.S. Postal Service today gave scouting 'a stamp of approval' to honor 100 years of the U.S. scouting movement. The Celebrate Scouting stamp, which will be sold in the summer of 2010, coincides with the Boy Scouts of America's 100th anniversary.

The new stamp design was unveiled last week during an event at the Smithsonian National Postal Museum. The design, created by illustrator Craig Frazier, depicts the spirit and outdoor adventure of scouting through a backpacking scout and a large silhouette of a scout surveying the landscape.

Since the creation of the international youth scouting movement some 100 years ago, hundreds of millions of children have benefited from opportunities for adventure, skill building, leadership, personal development, and community service provided by scouting organizations.

**“After God, the priest is everything. Only in heaven will the priest fully realize what he is.”  
St. John Vianney, the Cure of Ars**

Approximately four months remain before this **Year for Priests** comes to its conclusion. **Pope Benedict XVI** declared this special year to be observed from June 19, 2009 to June 19, 2010. At its conclusion, our Holy Father has invited priests throughout the world to join him in St. Peter’s Square for a special celebration. This year helps us to underline the fact that without priests, we would have no Holy Eucharist. And the Church herself could not survive without the Most Blessed Sacrament, God Himself in our midst.

The Year for Priests has also been called, we are certain, to highlight the need to pray for our priest and for vocations to the priesthood. We know that God works most often through ordinary, human means. Many men have never responded to God’s call simply because nobody has ever suggested to them to consider becoming a priest.

What have you done during this special year for priests? Have you prayed for priests....*truly prayed for them* in light of the awesome gift which the priesthood is? Are you still casting a negative view on ALL priests because of the sins of a FEW (for priests are, and always will be, weak and human as we all are)? Why do we find it easier to be judge and jury, criticizing and condemning priests and bishops when they make decisions that are unpopular and hurtful? Where is our true spirit of Christian charity? Are we praying for the perseverance of our seminarians in formation so they will be ordained holy and good priest according to the mind of Christ the High Priest and the saintly model of John Marie Vianney, the holy and humble patron saint of all priests?

Our Lord continues to call men to the priesthood. It can be a calling that comes at any time: for a young man out of high school, or in college, or after a first or second career. We have the example of the latter in the Gospel among some of the Apostles. Many, like Simon Peter, our first Pope, were fishermen by trade. **“Fear not,”** Jesus says to them after they witness an amazing catch of fish they made at the command of Jesus. Simon Peter himself asked Jesus to depart from him as he considered himself too sinful to be His follower. But Jesus persisted in His call to Peter, along with the sons of Zebedee, James and John. The older translation relates Jesus’ words the best: **“Fear not. From now on, you shall be fishers of men.”** (cf.: **Luke 5:1-11**) This means that Jesus calls men to His priesthood so that they will be His instruments in the world to offer, first and foremost, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and to save souls for heaven.

The priesthood is greater than any one man. It is an awesome and mysterious gift that, as St. John Vianney says in the quote at the start of this column, will never be fathomed completely in this life. **As this Year for Priests continues, we need to thank God.** From Pope Benedict to the most newly ordained priest, our Catholic Church has been blessed with a majority of holy, hardworking, and humble priests who, before their own interests, work daily for the salvation of the People of God entrusted to their care.
