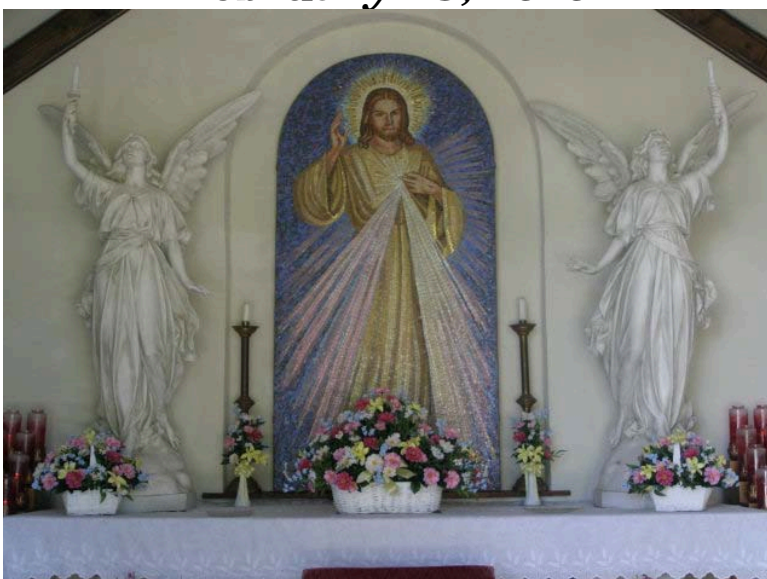

“Joined Through Time & Space”

Following the Consecration of the bread and wine into the Most Sacred body and Precious Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ, the priest concludes the Second Eucharistic Prayer with the following words: ***“Have mercy on us all; make us worthy to share eternal life with Mary, the Virgin Mother of God, with the Apostles, and with all the saints who have done your will throughout the ages. May we praise You in union with them, and give You glory through Your Son, Jesus Christ.”***

The Gospel for the **Second Sunday in Lent** is always the account of Our Lord’s Transfiguration before the Apostles Peter, James and John on Mount Tabor. As these three followers of Jesus are given a glimpse of His divinity, they also witness two others on either side of the Lord, Moses and Elijah who symbolized the Law and the Prophets.

Those Old Testament figures were never formally canonized. But neither were countless others who are in heaven. Among these are most likely people many of us have know either in person (e.g., family members, friends) or by reputation (e.g., Pope John Paul II) who sought to follow the will of God instead of their own and lead exemplary lives. While we won’t know precisely who is there until we ourselves get to heaven (*God willing!*), there’s little reason to doubt that Elijah and Moses now share the Beatific vision along with Our Blessed Mother Mary and the other saints.

Holy Mother Church invites us to observe the Season of Lent through the means of **Prayer, penance, fasting, and almsgiving**, to the best of our abilities and circumstances. Another practice that many follow in Lent is to **attend Mass** beyond just our Sunday obligation, perhaps on a daily basis. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is the greatest prayer and our supreme act of adoration as Catholics. Each time we assist at Mass, we participate **“in remembrance of Me,”** as Jesus commanded all His followers.

The Mass reaches across time and space. In every Mass, the priest and congregation are at Calvary, the one and only Sacrifice of the Cross, Jesus is never “re-crucified” as many non-Catholics (and some misinformed Catholics) believe. His Sacrifice was accomplished once and for all on Calvary. At each and every Mass, from the first at the Last Supper to the most recent this day, time is suspended and we are actually at the foot of the Cross with Our Lady, St. John and St. Mary Magdalene. We should be conscious of this fact. This is why the Holy Mass, whether attended by thousands with the Holy Father, hundreds at a Sunday Mass, or a mere handful at a quiet weekday Mass is never a solitary event, even if the priest celebrates a private Mass. Each participant is joined together with persons present, as well as all the faithful, as the Second Eucharistic Prayer says above, **“throughout the ages.”**

If you are looking to add another meaningful practice for your Lenten journey, and your schedule will permit (perhaps with a bit of juggling), why not consider attending Mass on one other day in addition to the Lord’s Day? The more we go to Mass and receive Holy Communion worthily, the more we will want to be there. That extra day of attending Mass might possibly turn into a second, or third time per week.

A Special Lenten Fast

Give up harsh words – use generous ones

Give up unhappiness – take up gratitude

Give up anger – take up gentleness and patience

Give up pessimism – take up hope and optimism

Give up worrying – take up trust in God

Give up complaining – value what you have

Give up stress – take up prayer

Give up judging others – discover Jesus within them

Give up sorrow and bitterness – fill your heart with joy

Give up selfishness – take up compassion for others

Give up being unforgiving – learn reconciliation

Give up words – fill yourself with silence, and listen to others
