## **“Half-Time: Continue to Engage”**

We have come to the midway point in Lent. Today is known as **Laetare Sunday**. **Laetare** is the Latin word for **rejoice**, the first word in today’s Entrance Antiphon. Today, rose-colored vestments are permitted in place of penitential purple, as is the use of flowers to adorn the sanctuary. We could call Laetare Sunday our “Half-time” for Lent.

Laetare Sunday should be both a cause for rejoicing and personal “alarm.” Forty days of Lent may seem like an interminable amount of time, but in truth, the days past swiftly. It’s too easy to get lost in anticipating the joyous celebration of the Resurrection on **Easter** in only three weeks, while forgetting to check how well we have been doing this Lent. *Have I been praying more, reading more Sacred Scripture? Attending Mass when obligated, but on other days as well? Participating in Stations of the Cross or other Lenten devotions? Disciplining myself by giving up a sinful habit, or trying to conquer a certain addiction...alcoholism, pornography, drug abuse? Fasting on the appointed days, and on others of my own choosing? Abstaining from meat on Fridays? Making a sacrifice to go without some daily “crutch” that I think I can’t live without (e.g., the cell phone, the internet, the ipod, driving when I could be walking).*

Let us look at one area. Prayer is our conversation with God, but unless we pray every day and often, our prayer life won’t grow. This is critical for our spiritual life. In this **Year for Priests**, consider praying a **Rosary for Priests** as part of your Lenten program. While the others mysteries are available, we present here the Sorrowful Mysteries.

**The Agony in the Garden** ~ we pray that all priests who are suffering and on the way to Calvary may be comforted by God’s presence; those who have betrayed or denied the Faith through weakness may repent and return to the warmth of God’s love. We pray that all priests may live only to do our Father’s will, as Jesus always did.

**Jesus is Scourged** ~ we pray for priests who are persecuted, physically or mentally abused; those who are imprisoned or prevented from offering the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass or receiving Communion, and for those priests living in oppressive regimes.

**Jesus is Mocked and Crowned with Thorns** ~ we pray for priest who suffer for defending authentic Catholic doctrine. We pray that all bishops will uphold the true teachings of the Catholic Church and resist temptations to compromise doctrine in the face of cultural and social pressures.

**Jesus Carries His Cross** ~ we pray for all priests with heavy crosses; those who are weak, lonely, or have fallen from God’s grace in some way. We pray for our Holy Father, who perhaps has the heaviest of crosses: the widespread persecution and abandonment of the Church from within and without.

**Jesus Dies on the Cross** ~ we pray for all priests who are in their last agony and those who will die today. We pray for those who thirst for the salvation of souls. We pray that the crucifixion of their wills may accomplish God’s designs for the salvation of the whole world. We pray that priests may take Mary into their hearts, as St. John the Apostle, one of the first priests, took Mary into his home.
