### *Haiti & The Cross*

January 12, 2010. You may not remember the date, but hopefully you have not forgotten the major event on that day. That was the date the devastating 7.0 magnitude earthquake rocked Haiti on the island of Hispaniola. The Presidential Palace, Parliament, the Cathedral of Port au-Prince and other important structures were destroyed, along with countless dwellings of the inhabitants of this poor nation. But most horrifying was the amount of dead: some 150,000, though the exact number may never be known. The televised images cannot adequately convey to us the loss of life and devastation. It's nearly incomprehensible, and after such a catastrophic event, a "return to normalcy" may seem impossible. Indeed, it will take months, and perhaps years before even a hint of a "normal routine" returns to life in Haiti. Hopefully we have not forgotten the people of Haiti in our prayers and our monetary support. The cross they bear is tremendous and heavy.

When a tragedy such as the Haitian earthquake occurs, it should help the rest of us to put things in perspective. We all have our share of daily crosses, but most of them pale in comparison. Perhaps I can forego groaning that my meal wasn't cooked precisely the way I prefer in that restaurant / Maybe that broken or missing cell phone doesn't mean the "end of my world" / Waiting for that Internet connection beyond the usual few seconds isn't such a big deal after all. There are crosses, and there are Crosses.

In the extraordinary form of the Mass (Missal of Blessed John XXIII), this fifth Sunday in the Lenten Season is known as "Passion Sunday," or the "First Sunday in Passiontide" which ushers in the final two weeks of Lent. Elements of this are even found in the ordinary form of Mass (Missal of Paul VI) and Liturgy of the Hours (Divine Office), as the prayers and hymns all allude to the Passion and the Holy Cross. Statues, images, and crucifixes are covered until Good Friday and Holy Saturday, making the observer take note that a more intense period of Lent, focusing on the Lord's Passion, has begun. We begin to recall the most important events of our redemption,.

As Jesus went to Jerusalem, He knew the Cross that awaited Him. Sometimes we are aware or have some hint of a situation before us that will turn out to be a difficult cross to bear. Other times, it comes as a surprise and we pray to have the strength to bear (e.g., a sudden illness, death or unexpected event). The importance is not to pray if we will have a cross to bear, because Jesus Himself told us "in the world you will have troubles." (John 16:33a) It's rather how we will bear our crosses. "You will weep and mourn while the world rejoices; you will grieve," Jesus tells us because we cannot escape the Cross in this life. "But your grief will become joy." (John 16:20) If we accept our crosses always in concert with Christ, no matter how heavy the burden, He helps us to carry them. "Do not be afraid, I have overcome the works." (John 16:33b)

In this final phase of Lent, this Passiontide, let us unite ourselves and the daily events of life, small and large, with Jesus. As we walk faithfully with Him to Jerusalem, to His Passion and Crucifixion, we can be certain we will share in His Resurrection.
