“One ‘Titanic’ Passenger”

April 15, 2010 marked the **98th anniversary** of the sinking of the great **R.M.S. Titanic**. The largest ocean liner of her time, she struck an iceberg on her maiden voyage from Southampton, England to New York City and sank within a couple of hours. Titanic’s demise resulted in the deaths of 1517 people and the end of an era.

Dedicated and astute devotees of the 1997 film *“Titanic”* will recall the following scene as the great ocean liner came closer to her plunge into the icy Atlantic Ocean. After the iceberg fatally wounded the Titanic, many of the passengers trapped onboard (due to the minimum number of lifeboats required at that time) were scrambling, as best they could, away from the approaching waters toward the ever-upturning stern.

Father Thomas Byles (1870-1912), an English priest and passenger on his way to officiate at his younger brother’s wedding in New York, prayed the rosary, heard confessions and granted absolution to comfort doomed passengers.

The film depicts the heroism of Father Byles as people gathered about him. He quotes a passage from the Book of the Apocalypse (Revelation), the same one that is read on the **Fifth Sunday of Easter** (cycle C): ***“I, John, saw a new heaven and a new earth. The former heaven and the former earth has passed away, and the sea was no longer....[God] will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there shall be no more death or mourning...for the old order has passed away.”*** (cf.: Rev. 21:1-5a) Like so many others, Father Byles died in the sinking. His body was never identified.

As we enter May, the beautiful month dedicated to our Blessed Mother Mary and in which we honor our own earthly mothers, it may seem misplaced, perhaps morbid, to recall a scene of such tragedy and sadness. But life has both joys and sorrows; to believe otherwise, is to be naive or in denial. As Christians, we know that we have on this planet no lasting city, that our time here is short, and that as lovely as springtime can be, all this too shall pass away. We are created by and made for God. So we should live each day to the fullest, not in fear and despair, but rather with joyful hope and expectation for we know neither the day nor the hour when God will call us to Himself. Some have the luxury of a long life, with time to prepare. But we know that death often occurs suddenly: the recent **devastating earthquakes** in Haiti, Chile and Turkey; the **horrific plane crash** that robbed Poland of **President Lech Kaczynski**, his wife, and scores of other Polish military, political and religious dignitaries on April 10, 2010.

In this Sunday’s Gospel we hear these words of Jesus: ***“I give you a new commandment: love one another.”*** (cf.: **John 13:31-33a; 34-35**) Does my life as a follower of Christ truly reflect Him to others? Am I so preoccupied with this world and my needs that I neglect others, nor take the time to ponder the life of the world to come?

Equally striking/challenging are Jesus’ words that immediately follow: ***“As I have loved you, so you should also love one another. By this will all know that you are my disciples, that you love one another.”*** Jesus emphasizes *both* our words and our actions. Father Byles demonstrated and lived these words of Jesus. Given the opportunity, would I be prepared and respond as selflessly as he did in those last moments on the Titanic?
