“The Steady Ship in Stormy Seas”

The Holy Father visits Portugal from May 11-14, 2010. May 13th, the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima is also the 29th anniversary of the assassination attempt of **Pope John Paul II**, a dark and unforgettable day in 1981 for those of us old enough to remember.

Venerable John Paul II nearly died on that day. He attributed the saving of his life to the intervention of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Now his successor **Pope Benedict XVI** visits the Portuguese faithful and renders his filial devotion to Our Lady as well.

The attacks on John Paul didn't end in 1981. Throughout his quarter century pontificate, he was also attacked verbally, from outside of and from within the Church by many who considered him too conservative and in his final years, too old and feeble.

On April 16th, Our Holy Father Benedict recently observed the fifth anniversary of his election to the Supreme Pontificate. But the joy of that milestone was muted. Over the preceding weeks, Pope Benedict has also been verbally attacked with misinformed and unsubstantiated innuendos. Calumny is a grave sin, and the Holy Father has endured slander after slander. *Why? What is the real reason behind this?*

It is ironic that those criticizing His Holiness on what he did or did not do to prevent/prosecute/judge/condemn sexual abuse of minors by clergy and religious, are the same ones who condemned him before he was pope for being “*God’s Rottweiler*” or the “*Panzer Cardinal*” in his steadfast defense of the faith. **Then was too harsh. Now he’s not harsh enough.** The fact is that no one could have imagined the scope of the sin and crime of sexual abuse of minors throughout society. But anyone with an ounce of fairness and reason will understand that since the scandal broke, the Catholic Church has been the most transparent institution to address the tragic situation. The Church has apologized to the victims and put in place procedures to prevent future occurrences. Although one incident is too many, the low number of new allegations is proof to this. We have yet to hear what other institutions are doing to clean up and prevent sexual abuse.

Further, it must not be forgotten that the sexual abuse of minors was “enabled” by the sexual revolution of the last four to five decades. It was the time to emphasize that priest and religious were “real” people, too, “just like everybody else.” Contraception; pre-marital, extra-marital, homosexual relations; abortions exploded with the “*If it feels good, do it*” mentality. Might the sexual abuse tragedy have been less, or avoided completely had everyone adhered to the Ten Commandments (specifically the Sixth) and the Church which teach that the only legitimate place for sexual relations is between one man and one woman within the context of marriage?

St. John Bosco had a vision of Holy Mother Church as a ship being attacked on all sides and buffeted by stormy seas. On either side, two tall pillars anchored the ship, one capped by the Holy Eucharist and the other by Our Lady. Standing firm at the bow of the vessel was the “captain,” a man dressed in white, representing the Pope.

As our Holy Father Benedict prays at the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima, we join in prayer that she will continue to watch over and protect all her children, especially the most vulnerable, and guide the Vicar of Christ through these contemporary storms.
