“Winter and Spring Battles”

The beauty of springtime is one of God’s marvelous gifts to us. After the stark, cold of winter, new life has burst forth upon the scene. The barren trees are re-clothed with new leaves, grass has turned green and lush, all sorts of plants and shrubs are in bloom, and vegetable gardens are beginning to grow. In early spring, however, winter is often not quite ready to loosen its grip. This is evident in those springtime moments, even days, when clouds, wind and rain are prominent, along with dipping temperatures and scattered frosts thrown in for good measure. Eventually, the warmth and sunshine of spring usually win out over the remnants of winter, but not without a struggle.

Our contemporary society is engaged in a winter vs. spring-like battle. Unlike the seasons, the outcome of this battle is uncertain. The “Enlightenment” period (which began approximately in the late 17th century) saw the separation of two schools of thought that until then co-existed throughout recorded history, i.e., the necessary link between faith and reason. Beginning in Europe, and gaining momentum during the 18th century American and French revolutions, many intellectuals and scientists were convinced that God---and thereby faith in Him and those institutions dedicated to Him----- was merely a fanciful myth that belonged to ignorant and uncivilized times.

Since the beginning of his pontificate, **Pope Benedict XVI** has been emphasizing, time and again, the need for the continued existence of **faith and reason: the two are not opposed, but complimentary**. The Holy Father warns that **when one tries to exist the other, extreme situations occur**. This is true with the brand of radical Islam that strips away reason in order to pursue a violent agenda. On the other had, certain elements in the West are determined to remove any shred of faith from the public scene. Unfortunately there are too many examples of this, but a recent one is a ruling by a U.S. judge that a *National Day of Prayer* is unconstitutional. Our founding fathers would probably be both appalled and confused about such an assertion.

Like winter weather intruding upon the spring, our culture has been severely damaged by the assault on belief in God and practicing faith in general. If this secularization continues, the fabric of society will continue to rot. Each must ask: *Do I believe in God? Do I make time in my day for Him? Am I doing anything to halt this fatal cultural decline, or am I contributing to it? Will I welcome the Lord when He calls me?*

The warmth of a new day quickly supplants the memory of a previous, unseasonably chilly one. The erosion of faith from our culture has been happening, for the most part, in subtle ways--but no less deadly---and so the ordinary person tends not to notice, or sadly chooses to close his eyes to the facts.

It should be obvious to any thinking person that, at the moment, in all of this battling madness between faith and reason, faith is losing. Jesus tells us, **“Behold, I am coming soon. I bring with Me the recompense I will give to each according to his deeds. I Am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last, the beginning and the end.”** Cf.: Rev. 22:12-14, 16-17, 20) Do I acknowledge my own need for faith in my life and our society? Am I courageously living my faith in a way that will always please God?
