“Our Moral Fabric is Torn.”

The Catholic Church has been taken to task for the sexual abuse of young people that has occurred over the decades, and rightly so. The exploitation of the innocent by some members of the clergy and religious is both sinful and criminal. Since these painful situations have come to light, the Church has responded and set in place procedures for the protection against such further abuse. Contrary to comments by some secular media and others, **Pope Benedict XVI** has worked vigorously to address these situations. Church offenders have either been laicized or resigned. Our Holy Father and numerous bishops’ conferences have apologized to and met with victims. This problem must be confronted honestly, and society at large must realize that **sexual abuse is not a problem exclusive to the Catholic Church** herself. If the sexual abuse in the public schools becomes public knowledge, the numbers would be staggering. Nor is this solely a problem of pedophilia. The vast majority of abuse victims by male clergy were adolescent males, and that sobering fact must be addressed.

Sexual abuse is but one problem facing today’s world. We have only to consider a few recent news headlines and realize that the moral fabric of our society has been torn to shreds. *A few examples from the end of April 2010:*

In Rossano, Italy, a 22-week-old baby boy who survived an abortion died two days after being left without care.

In Taixing, China, a man entered a school and slashed 29 kindergarteners, ages 4-5, some seriously. Two teachers and a guard were also wounded. This was the second such attack in as many days.

In Connecticut, an 18-year-old male stabbed his 18-year-old live-in girlfriend multiple times. She died of her injuries. They had graduated together from high school the previous year.

In the light of such atrocities, a public outcry is heard. ***Something must be done!*** But instead of turning to God, politically correct answers are sought elsewhere.

Massachusetts made national news with the South Hadley suicide case that threw a spotlight on school bullying. In response, the state legislature passed an anti-bullying bill. While there is nothing wrong with such a law, it will be difficult to enforce unless children are taught from the start that bullying is not acceptable. That means that **parents cannot remain “missing in action”** when it comes to teaching morals in the home. Whether parents like to hear it or not: ***IT ALL STARTS IN THE HOME.*** The “sexual revolution” of permissiveness and absentee parents have only contributed to the destruction of the Judeo-Christian values upon which this nation was built.

All of this occurs as the European Union chose not to acknowledge its Christian roots (thereby leaving God out of the picture) and elements in American society continue to use the false argument of “separation of church and state,” found nowhere in the Constitution (again, to remove God from the public square). Is it any coincidence that **when man turns his back on God that he is simultaneously destroying the very foundations of a civilized society?**
