“The True Bread from Heaven.”

As every Catholic should know, **Holy Thursday** commemorates the Last Supper. On that evening before His death, Our Lord Jesus Christ, gathered with His Apostles, took the ordinary bread and wine for the Passover, pronounced a blessing and declared those elements to be His Body and Blood. With that action and those words, He established the **Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist** which was completed by His Sacrificial death on the cross the following day.

Another title for this day is **Maundy Thursday**. “Maundy” is from the Latin *mandatum*, i.e., commandment. When He says, “*This is My Body, given for you. Do this in remembrance of Me.....This cup is the new covenant in My Blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.*” (cf.: I Cor. 11:23-26) Jesus commands His Apostles, the first priests, to perpetuate His Sacrifice until He comes again.

Thus, Holy Thursday, we are reminded in the **Year for Priests**, is also the day of the institution of the **Sacrament of Holy Orders**. Thus, the first day of the Paschal Triduum gives us two of the vital Seven Sacraments of the Church.

Since the overriding focus on Holy Thursday is, however, the Passion and death of Our Lord, Holy Mother Church saw fit to create a separate celebration to give due homage and adoration to the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Eucharist.

The **Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ**, commonly referred to as “**Corpus Christi**” (Latin for *Body of Christ*) was created by **Pope Urban IV** in 1264. It was the first feast to be observed through the universal Church sanctioned by papal decree. St. Thomas Aquinas (1225-1274), the great Dominican theologian, composed the Mass and Divine Office for Corpus Christi which include the timeless hymns, *Pange Lingua* (sung during the Procession with the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose on Holy Thursday), *Panis Angelicus* (“Bread of Angels”), and the familiar Benediction melodies, *O Salutaris Hostia* (“O Saving Victim”) and *Tantum Ergo* (“Down in Adoration Falling”). The beautiful **Sequence** of the Mass for Corpus Christi, *Lauda, Sion Salvatorem* (“Sion, praise your Savior”) was also composed the “Angelic Doctor.”

The Feast of Corpus Christi is celebrated on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday. In some countries (e.g., Austria, Colombia, Poland), it is a holiday. If not observed as a Holyday of Obligation (as in the U.S.), the feast is transferred to Sunday after Trinity Sunday. For centuries, this feastday has been accompanied by a **Procession with the Blessed Sacrament to four altars**. A Eucharist-themed Gospel is read and Benediction imparted at each altar. This is symbolic of the fact that the real presence of Our Lord Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist goes forth to the four corners of the earth.

Above all, the Feast of Corpus Christi is our opportunity to demonstrate **our core Catholic belief** that in the Most Blessed Sacrament of the Altar, in that tiny piece of consecrated bread is contained the true Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Jesus. It is no mere symbol; It is the One, Almighty, Omnipotent God Who makes Himself small and fragile so that we, free from any serious sin, may find nourishment for our souls.
