“From the Tiniest of Seeds.”

“The rash man has no integrity. The just one, because of his faith, shall live.” (cf.: Habbakuk 2:4)

There’s nothing wrong with a little acknowledgment. We all can use *“a pat on the back”* once in awhile---whether at work or school or at home---just to be sure we’re on the right track. It’s nice to know that our efforts are appreciated. But we shouldn’t expect praise 24/7 in our ordinary, routine tasks. In those instances, we’re just doing what we’re supposed to be doing. Constant praise is unrealistic and ridiculous; “exceptional” and “special” would lose their meaning. In life’s ordinary events and tasks, all we need do is our best. Acknowledgment or not, God is ever aware and is always appreciative.

This is what Our Lord is talking about in the Gospel passage for the 27th Sunday of the Year (cycle C): **The Apostles said to the Lord, “Increase our faith.”**

The Lord replied, “If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, ‘Be uprooted and planted in the sea,’ and it will obey you.

“Who among you would say to your servant who has just come in from plowing or tending sheep in the field, ‘Come here immediately and take your place at table’? Would he not rather say to him, ‘Prepare something for me to eat. Put on your apron and wait on me while I eat and drink. You may eat and drink when I am finished’? Is he grateful to that servant because he did what was commanded? So should it be with you. When you have done all you have been commanded, say, ‘We are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do’.” (cf.: Luke 17:5-10)

“God helps those who help themselves” goes an old saying that’s ignored by many today. Instead the world is full of lots of whiners. Haven’t we all experienced that person who expects us to bend over backwards for him/her, often at a moment’s notice, but puts forth little or no cooperation or assistance? That’s as wrong as when I make demands on God’s graciousness and magnanimity. God always fills in what we may be lacking as long as we do our duty. That’s when we are sincere disciples.

The world today is very complicated. Faith is not. But faith requires a daily personal leap, a commitment, even when we struggle....*especially* when we struggle.

When this column began, some dozen years ago, back in the day of the Sts. Peter & Paul **“Parish Chronicle,”** the title was not a random choice. **“A Mustard Seed”** meant to convey then, as well as now, that the words written here are but a tiny microcosm among thousands of Catholic columns, most far more eloquent, creative, lofty, and venerable. Our words here, within the context of our wonderful Catholic faith, will not be long remembered. But at the same time, by God’s grace and with the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, it is hoped that one or two of these columns, or a tiny portion of one, despite their insignificance, may make you ponder, inspire a momentary reflection, offer a bit of common sense, a new perspective, or even smile. Like that tiny mustard seed, a deeper appreciation, understanding, and desire for our faith may develop as we strive to live it out in these uncertain, challenging times.

[P.S.: This week’s topic is not meant to elicit “a pat on the back”!]
