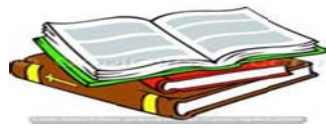

“The Real Work of Each Day.”

Colorful leaves have fallen, exposing the trees like spidery patterns against the horizon. The season deepens, daylight lessens, and night shadows lengthen. With only two months left in the calendar year, the Church year also approaches its finish. The liturgy directs us to endings, personal and universal, and the need of daily conversion.

“You [God] rebuke offenders, little by little, warn them, and remind them of the sins they are committing.” (cf.: Wisdom 12:2) Life is a pilgrimage. Where will I spend eternity? Am I ready to be in the presence of Almighty God, Who is pure goodness and love? If not, of what must I rid myself to be worthy? Am I suitably concerned with **The FOUR LAST THINGS TO BE REMEMBERED: *Death – Judgment – Hell – Heaven?***

An old prayer, simply titled, *Daily Meditations*, can assist in this examination ~

“Remember, O Christian soul, that you have in this and each day: God to glorify – Jesus to imitate – the Angels and Saints to invoke – A soul to save – A body to mortify – Sins to expiate – Virtues to acquire – Hell to avoid – Heaven to gain – Eternity to prepare for – Time to profit by – Neighbors to edify – The world to despise – Devils to combat – Passions to subdue – Death perhaps to suffer – Judgment to undergo.”

“Sins to expiate/Devils to combat.” – How many deny that there is such a thing as sin or that the devil exists? This in turn delights the great deceiver Satan, “the father of lies.” How few accept personal responsibility for their actions when they are at fault!

“Heaven to gain.” – Let’s hope that most people want to spend eternity in Heaven! But how many today are working to achieve that goal, doing their best to flee temptations and avoid sin as often as possible? When sin has been committed, do we admit our faults and implore God’s Mercy in the Sacrament of Penance?

“Passions to subdue.” – We are bombarded today by the exact opposite message from society. Particularly troubling is the magnitude of sexual manipulation that our youth face daily. Sexual situations and innuendos are common on television and pornography is like a cancer on the internet, exploiting females and males. Girls and young women are taught they should be respected, not looked upon as mere sexual objects. But almost at the same time, they are enticed by the media and fashion industry to purchase and wear clothing that is provocative, tempting, and borderline obscene. Are adults doing their part to learn about these deceptions; to instruct, guide, and protect young persons? For that matter, do we protect ourselves from these “*devils to combat*”?

The Lord is waiting for us. ***“The Son of Man has come to seek and to save what was lost.” (cf. Luke 19:10)*** Now is the time for His Mercy. Don’t waste the time, for after it comes His judgment when each will receive what his/her deeds deserve.

Prepare and entrust yourself to the foster father of Jesus – ***O faithful Guardian and Father of virgins, Blessed Joseph, to whom was confided the care of Jesus, and of Mary the Queen of Virgins, I most humbly supplicate thee, by the love thou didst bear Jesus and Mary, to obtain for me that, being preserved from every stain during my whole life, I may be ever able to serve them with unspotted purity of mind and body. Amen.***
