“Blessed John Henry Newman.”

If you only heard about **Pope Benedict XVI’s** recent visit to **Scotland and England** from the secular media, then you learned very little. It seems that the only thing the media deems newsworthy regarding the Holy Father, and, by extension, the Catholic Church, is the sexual abuse scandal. And so news reports---print, television, internet---reported on the **Sept. 16-19** journey to the British Isles by starting with the Holy Father’s now customary news conference on the plane en route from Rome to Scotland.

Pope Benedict was asked, for the “umpteenth” time, about the sexual abuse crisis. He again expressed his profound sorrow over the scandal, his sympathy and concern for the victims, and the steps the Church has taken to prevent any re-occurrence. Was this acceptable? For some secular media; those seeking only monetary profit and the complete destruction of the Church, they will *never* be satisfied.

On the other hand, following the Holy Father’s journey to the United Kingdom by way of religious media (e.g., EWTN, www.vatican.va, and other solid Catholic websites) gave the true picture. By the end of the trip, everyone---including skeptics in Great Britain---was proclaiming the visit a resounding success. Whether the faithful in the United Kingdom respond to the challenges laid before them by the Pontiff remains to be seen. We earnestly pray that God will be the main priority of our fellow Catholics.

On the final day of his trip, the Holy Father declared **John Henry Cardinal Newman, “Blessed.”** The beatification of this former Anglican churchman was the first such ceremony presided over by Pope Benedict. He has ordinarily delegated beatifications to cardinals, reserving the final step of canonizations to himself. That makes this beatification an historic one, and for other reasons as well.

Newman has been an important influence on Pope Benedict’s own life and thought. **“His insights into the relation between faith and reason,”** said the Pope in the beatification homily, **“into the vital place of revealed religion in civilized society...continue today to inspire and enlighten many all over the world.”**

Saints are generally celebrated on the day of their death (the “day of birth” [*dies natalis*] into heaven). Instead of doing the same with the new Blessed, the Holy Father chose as the feast day **October 9**, the day Newman was received into the Catholic Church in 1845 at age 44. Blessed John Henry Newman, therefore, is presented to us as a convert who, after a long struggle, embraced the fullness of the true Faith which he found in the Catholic Church. *What a witness!* If the Pope had said or done nothing more than beatify John Henry Newman while in the United Kingdom, it would have been enough. The faithful of that realm, along with all of us Catholics, have been given yet another solid example of sanctity, and that real possibility and path open for each of us.

“God has created me to do Him some definitive service” wrote Newman in “Mediations on Christian Doctrine, one of his best-loved works. *“He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another.”* May we perform that specific work!

Blessed John Henry Newman, pray for us.
