“Indeed, They Are Holy Souls.”

It is both holy and noble to pray for our beloved dead on any day of the year, but sometimes we forget. Because our lives are so busy, Holy Mother Church sets aside the month of November to remind us to remember and pray for the souls in purgatory.

When we pray for the dead, we aren't praying for the saints in heaven. They have no need, because they have “already arrived,” so to speak. However, we certainly turn to the saints and ask for their assistance in intercessory prayer. We have numerous choices, from our Blessed Mother Mary to the recently beatified Blessed John Henry Newman. The Church has canonized thousands of persons, declaring that they are saints in heaven, worthy of our veneration for them and our seeking their intercession.

When it comes to our relatives and friends who have died, however, we cannot be quite so certain. Yes, we hope and pray they are in heaven, or on their way there. But none of us can be so bold as to declare that we know without a doubt that a particular person we know is in heaven, no matter how blessed a life we believe he or she lived.

The Church teaches that after death, there are three “points of destination” that a soul may reach, namely: **heaven, purgatory, or hell**. Just as we cannot authoritatively state that we know someone is in heaven (better to say/pray, “*we hope and pray this is so.*”), likewise we cannot declare that someone is in hell. Again, one's actions in life may have been so public and dreadful that it seems likely he/she is consigned to hell for eternity (e.g. a Hitler or a Saddam Hussein). But still we don't have that knowledge.

Purgatory is that state of being between life and death in which the soul finds him/herself still in need of further **purification**. Each human being inherits original sin from our first parents, Adam and Eve. This is wiped away in Baptism, but the effects remain throughout our life. Thus, in our human weakness, we are still prone to sin.

Our sins are forgiven in the Sacrament of Penance, but we still may need to make retribution for them. *A simple example:* I deliberately break a window; I am sorry for it and apologize to the owner; the owner forgives me. Yet there still remains the matter of the repair or replacement of the window. When we are unable to make satisfactory retribution in life for our sins, it is in purgatory that this is completed.

Purgatory is a place of suffering. Interpretations vary as to what form this suffering takes. The knowledge that one is so close to heaven, though still separated, is enough cause for pain. In that sense, we may call the souls in purgatory, “**poor,**” for they are still being purified before being admitted to the beatific vision, God Himself.

Another description for the souls which is just as valid is “the **holy** souls.” Some object, saying the souls are in wretched punishment. That's not quite true. While the souls suffer from the absence of God, they are also consoled by the fact that **the only place a soul may go from purgatory is heaven**. Their ultimate sanctity is assured by the very fact that they have come to that state where they are purged of any remaining sins and faults. In that sense, they *are* HOLY souls. They need our prayers for their passage to heaven, and we can be sure that once there, they will continue to help us to reach that same goal. This is all part of the mysterious, wonderful Communion of Saints.
