“Each Family’s Vital Ingredients.”

The **Christmas Season** should especially be a time when families gather, resolve differences if necessary, and be grateful for each other. At this time, the Church gives us two important celebrations that we may call “feasts of the family.” Joys and sorrows are presented in both, just as are found in the daily lives of ordinary families.

The Sunday in the Octave of Christmas is the **Feast of the Holy Family**. Jesus, Mary, and Joseph are the models of the family *par excellence*. They show us what each human family should strive to become. It’s tempting to say, “*no family can be like them*” simply because they were the Holy Family. But they, too, faced tremendous challenges. What must not be forgotten is that in good and bad times, it’s vital for each family member: mother, father, child to have mutual respect, “*compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.*” Properly taught by parents from the start, their children will not only learn how to live in all circumstances in the family, but in society at large.

With Mary’s conception of the Infant Jesus by the power of the Holy Spirit, Joseph was confused. He was frightened, more for her than for himself. Yet he didn’t abandon her. Both Joseph and Mary put their trust in the Lord. They made a commitment to each other in marriage. Despite an enforced worldwide census by the Roman Emperor, they made a difficult journey to the city of David where Jesus was born in circumstances that no parents would desire for their child.

The newborn Infant was not even one year old when the Holy Family hastily departed from Nazareth (cf.: **Matthew 2:13-15; 19-23**). They lived as exiles in Egypt for years because a crazed, insecure puppet-king wanted to destroy the child Jesus. Their departure narrowly preceded Herod’s edict that all male children, age two and younger, should be killed. That brings us to the second feast we are highlighting. The fourth day of the Octave of Christmas, December 28, we celebrate the **Feast of the Holy Innocents**.

We have all heard of or experienced the diagnosis of diseases, sometimes fatal, in children; or the deaths of teenagers and young persons who die too young. The so-called “*choice*” of some mothers and fathers to abort their pre-born babies continues to be the greatest evil of our age. The death of the Innocents is likewise sad and perplexing. These are mysteries that the human mind can’t comprehend. Only in heaven will we know the answers to the “*why?*” of these situations and realize their purpose.

Because he willingly gave his life, **Saint Stephen** the deacon (December 26) is considered the first martyr of the Church. While the Holy Innocents were unaware of their situation, their blood was shed nonetheless as a witness to the Christ Whom they would come to know in heaven. The sacrifice of their lives literally saved Our Lord’s earthly life. But we know that Jesus, too, would shed His blood. On the Cross, Our Savior gave His life as a ransom for the Innocents’ and indeed for all of humanity.

The Holy Family never forgot to “clothe” their lives in *love, that is, the bond of perfection* which permitted God’s peace to direct all their thoughts, words, and actions (cf.: **Colossians 3:12-21**). As it was with them, so may it be with all families once again.
