Reclaim Respect for Life!

January 22, 1973 marks the anniversary of the highly flawed and tragic Supreme Court decision, *Roe v. Wade*, which permitted abortion on demand. As we approach that sad date, we join our prayers imploring God that the U.S. reverse the trend of the past forty decades, and become again a culture of life, respecting life in all of its stages.

A few days before his death on March 20, 2010, Father Paul Marx, O.S.B., founder of Human Life International, addressed the landmark (and unfortunately maligned) encyclical *Humanae Vitae* (“on human life”). The connections between the degrading of moral standards, the trivialization of sex, and abortion are undeniable.

In a horrible “domino effect” our culture has swiftly witnessed: the legalization of abortion; an increase in couples living together (and not in chastity); more out-of-wedlock births; the explosion of pornography; the increasing tolerance for both hetero- and homosexual fornication; and the “right” (demand) for same sex “marriage.”

Fr. Marx’s article, which we present below, underlines the accuracy of **Paul VI’s** predictions about what would happen if contraception became prevalent in society----

“On July 25, 1968, **Pope Paul VI’s *Humanae Vitae*** re-affirmed the Catholic teaching on life, love, and human sexuality. In that document, he listed the consequences of the life lived outside Catholic teaching. The Holy Father predicted that:

“Contraception would lead to conjugal infidelity / contraceptive practice would lead to a ‘general lowering of morality’ / contraception would lead men to cease respecting women in their totality and would cause them to treat women as ‘mere instruments of selfish enjoyment’ rather than as cherished partners / and finally, widespread acceptance of contraception by couples would lead to a massive imposition of contraception by unscrupulous governments.

“In other words, **Pope Paul VI predicted that contraception would evolve from ‘a lifestyle choice’ into a weapon of mass destruction.** How dreadfully this prophecy has been vindicated by population control and coercive sterilization programs, fertility reduction quotas and the promotion of abortion literally everywhere in the world.

“Contraception’s destruction of the integrity of the marital act---as unitive and procreative---has dire consequences for society and for our souls. Contraception, in other words, is a rejection of God’s view of reality. It is a wedge driven into the most intimate sphere of communion known to man outside of the Holy Sacrament of the Mass. It is a degrading poison that withers life and love, both in marriage and in society.

“By breaking the natural and divinely ordained connection between sex and procreation, women and men---but especially men---would focus on the hedonistic possibilities of sex. People would cease seeing sex as something that was intrinsically linked to new life and to the sacrament of marriage.”

Does anyone doubt that this is where we find ourselves today?

We shamefully acknowledge the death of millions of innocent lives. We must resolve to turn the tide, or be drowned under the engulfing waves of the culture of death.

He says that if it gets much worse, *he may have to let her in.....*
