Information (& Noise) Overload

Some may remember the venerable old “*Bob Steele Show*” which was broadcast on WTIC radio (Hartford, Conn.) for over fifty years. The late **Bob Steele** (1911-2002) hosted the program six days a week from 1936 until 1991. After his “retirement” the inimitable Mr. Steele continued to host the show on most Saturday mornings until his death. His program was a welcome mix of music, stories, birthday greetings, Bob’s corny but endearing jokes, famous (or infamous!) puns, and common sense reminders. In his “word of the day” segment, he provided just that: proper pronunciation for a new or old word. For most of his air time (5:30 to 10 A.M.), Bob didn’t need to do much talking.

Radio today falls mostly under two categories: music stations and “talk radio.” The former offers music, from classical to rock and everything in between. The latter are programs consisting of either monologues, dialogues, call-ins, or some combination. Typical discussions critique current events and analyze the never-ending political landscape. Rather than relax us, hearing all that chatter can fill us with more tension.

Then there’s television. Is it necessary for some of the local channels (e.g., 22, 40) to begin broadcasting news at 4:30 A.M.? (*Is it fair to their employees?*) Do we really need the news broadcast at 5:00, 5:30, and 6:00 P.M. *every evening?* Sit through that entire ninety minutes, and you notice how many stories are re-played. Not so long ago, we managed to survive and keep abreast of important events with merely a half hour of local, followed by another half hour of national news in the evening.

Since the explosion of cable TV, we have **news** on that medium, along with the internet and via other outlets, **literally 24 hours a day, seven days a week**. The “noise” of cell phones, emails, texting, etc., coupled with talk radio, television, cable, the internet, and all the other gadgets constantly barrage us with information, making us more tense. Some of it’s vital, but most of it, under the guise of “news,” feeds us with useless fodder. Many news programs today, because there is so much time to fill, have crossed the line and become “*info-tainment*,” i.e., a little bit of actual news sprinkled between advice, opinion polls, celebrity gossip, cooking recipes, and “cutesy” human interest stories.

Despite all that “continuing education” out there, are we *really* a better educated society? Why is there such a lack of common courtesy? We’re often obsessed with work/career, but lack appreciation for leisure and quiet. How many meetings do we sit through, hearing lots of words tossed about, laughing at stale jokes? Then we walk away realizing an hour or so of valuable time has been wasted with nothing really accomplished. **Real listening is almost a lost art; we talk too much and say little; we have become restless with silence. Yet it’s precisely in quiet and tranquility, not in tension, that we can best hear God speak to us.** We need to eliminate needless information, cut down on the verbiage in order to lessen the tensions, to listen for God.

Lastly, there’s the hiring of “consultants” in business and education which has soared in recent years. In some cases, a consultant might actually be useful. But many times, these persons end up making decisions which managers/executives *themselves should have made* in the first place. *But that’s a subject for another column!*
