**A Christian *Must Pray Daily***

Those of us of a certain age know all about the antics of **Lucy Ricardo** as superbly portrayed by the late Lucille Ball in “**I Love Lucy.**” Other generations know the adventures of the Ricardos and Mertzes from TV reruns, videocassette and now DVD. It was, *and is*, a genuinely funny, wholesome show whose purpose was achieved: *to make us laugh*. It did so without insult, or by resorting to vulgar innuendoes or situations.

Rarely, if ever, was “**I Love Lucy**” preachy. But that doesn’t mean good examples and lessons were lacking. In one episode, Lucy and Ricky (played by Desi Arnaz) were putting their baby son Ricky, Jr. to bed. As Lucy covered the boy with his blanket, Ricky gently whispered to his son, “**now, say your prayers.**” A tiny thing, probably unnoticed by most (also, 1950s television was spared from crazed, self-appointed “watchdogs” who pounce on anything smacking of faith, religion, or God). But Ricky Ricardo’s simple request/advice to his son was a reminder, then and now, of the importance and need of **prayer for each of us, every day.**

Too many people run to God as the “problem solver.” They want His help for this or that matter, then promptly forget about Him. A one-sided relationship never survives. Others have no time at all for God and ignore Him. Some try to forbid any mention of God from the rest of us. We see what type of world is unfolding today when it tries to exclude Him. **Pope Benedict XVI**, in his recent book interview “*Light of the World,*” rightly teaches us that humanity needs to “*bring back God into the center [a] God Who knows us, speaks to us, and approaches us and Who is then our judge also.*”

To know and love God better, and to be happy with Him forever in eternity, daily prayer is required. Without a regular prayer life, we’ll never achieve an ongoing and maturing relationship with God. Prayer also brings us in touch with Our Lady and the Saints. It’s simple, but one must make time for prayer. Start with a morning prayer. Gradually add a prayer in the evening, then more during the day. Prayer can be spontaneous, for we are speaking with God. Well-known prayers, often written by saints, also help us to achieve a regular habit. Here is but one example: ***A Morning Offering ~***

*O my God, in union with the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer Thee the Precious Blood of Thy Divine Son Jesus from all the altars throughout the world, joining with It the offering of my every thought, word, and action of this day. O my Jesus, I desire today to gain every indulgence and merit I can. And I offer them, together with myself to Mary Immaculate, that she may best apply them to the interests of Thy Most Sacred Heart. Precious Blood of Jesus, save us. Immaculate Heart of Mary, pray for us. Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us. Dear Queen and Mother, who promised at Fatima to convert Russia and bring peace to all mankind, in reparation to thy Immaculate Heart for my sins and the sins of all the world, I solemnly pray to offer up every day the sacrifices demanded by my daily duty, to pray part of the Rosary meditating upon the mysteries, to wear the Scapular of Mount Carmel as a profession of this and as an act of consecration to thee. I shall renew this often, especially in moments of temptation. Amen.*
