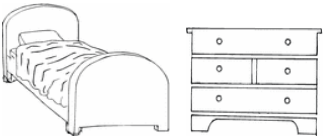


### **FAMILY CAMPOUT AT DIVINE MERCY PARISH – August 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup>**
