# FIFTY QUESTIONS ON THE ORDER OF MASS

## A Brief Examination of Practice

These brief reflections are about developing good habits. Habits of fidelity to the liturgical books of the Roman Rite. They are based upon a conviction that only through fidelity to the Church's liturgical texts and rites can we bring about an effective *Ars Celebrandi*, an art of celebrating the sacred liturgy with authenticity.

(Continued from last week)

### THE COLLECT

#### #15 ~ Why do we pause for silence after the "Let us pray"?

The pause is to allow the faithful to be made aware of being in God's presence and to call to mind their intentions.

### THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

#### #16 ~ What should the priest be doing during the readings?

It should be apparent that the priest and the ministers are listening intently to the Word of God as it is proclaimed.

#### #17 ~ Should periods of silence be observed in the Liturgy of the Word?

Sacred silence is observed throughout the celebration of the Mass: "...For in the Penitential Act and again after invitation to pray, individuals recollect themselves; whereas after a reading or after the Homily, all meditate briefly on what they have heard; then after Communion, they praise God in their hearts and pray to him. Even before the celebration itself, it is a praiseworthy practice for silence to be observed in the church, in the sacristy, in the vesting room, and in adjacent areas, so that all may dispose themselves to carry out the sacred celebration in a devout and fitting manner."

#### #18 ~ If, in a concelebration, the priest proclaims the Gospel, does he ask for the blessing?

The priest does not ask for the blessing from another priest. In the presence of a Bishop, he asks for the blessing from the Bishop.

#### #19 ~ When the priest imposes incense, does he bless it?

Each time the priest imposes incense he blesses it with a silent sign of the cross.

#### #20 ~ Does the priest bow before he incenses?

"A profound bow is made to the person or object that is incensed, except for the altar and the offerings for the Sacrifice of the Mass."
