**TRADITIONS**

Celebration of Epiphany in Poland – Feast of Three Kings

It is the beautiful custom in Poland to celebrate the Epiphany by using chalk and incense blessed by the priest. The chalk is used to mark the main doorpost of home, church, school, etc. with the following inscription which includes the new year and the first initials of the Wise Men, i.e., “K” Kaspar, “M” Melchior and “B” Balthazar.

**+20+K+M+B+12+**

The incense grains are safely burned over charcoal or some heat source while prayers are invoked for blessings in the new year through the intercession of the Magi, or Three Kings.

Formerly, in many parishes the resident priest(s) would visit the homes of every parishioner on Epiphany and perform this traditional blessing with the incense and chalk. This would also be the opportunity to conduct a census of the number of parishioners. The priest(s) would be accompanied by the parish organist who would bring a calendar for each home visited.

## FIFTY QUESTIONS ON THE ORDER OF MASS

### A Brief Examination of Practice

These brief reflections are about developing good habits. Habits of fidelity to the liturgical books of the Roman Rite. They are based upon a conviction that only through fidelity to the Church's liturgical texts and rites can we bring about an effective *Ars Celebrandi*, an art of celebrating the sacred liturgy with authenticity.

### THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST (continued)

#### #34 ~ When the priest mixes water with the wine, does he pray out loud?

No. This is among the private prayers of the priest. None of the prayers which the Order of Mass direct should be prayed quietly should be heard by the faithful.

#### #35 ~ How are the offerings incensed?

"The Priest incenses the offerings with three swings of the thurible or by making the Sign of the Cross over the offerings with the thurible before going on to incense the cross and the altar."

#### #36 ~ Does the priest wash his hands or his fingers?

The priest washes his hands as he asks the Lord to wash away his iniquity and cleanse him of his sins.

### THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

#### #37 ~ How should the priest choose which Eucharistic Prayer to use?

The choice of a Eucharistic Prayer should be governed by the General Instruction of the Roman Missal. However, it should also be borne in mind that "the Priest should be attentive rather to the common spiritual good of the People of God than to his own inclinations."

#### #38 ~ What gestures are used by the priest during the introductory dialogue?

When he says "The Lord be with you" he extends his hands, as at a greeting.

When he says "Lift up your hearts" he raises his hands. When he says, "Let us give thanks to the Lord our God" he, once again, extends his hands.

#### #39 ~ Does the priest pray the "Holy, Holy..." with the people?

Yes. The priest and people pray the "Holy, Holy..." However, while the priest offers the invitation "The mystery of faith," the people alone respond. Likewise, while the priest sings or says the doxology ("Through him, and with him, and in him..."), he does not sing or say the "Amen."
