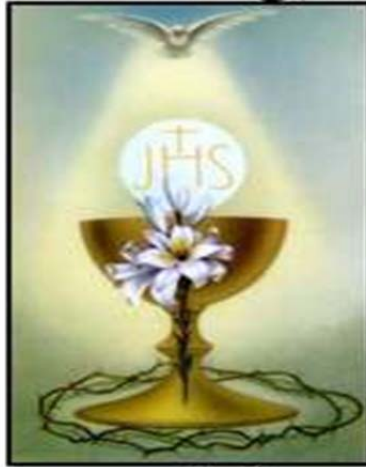

# FIFTY QUESTIONS ON THE ORDER OF MASS

## A Brief Examination of Practice

These brief reflections are about developing good habits. Habits of fidelity to the liturgical books of the Roman Rite. They are based upon a conviction that only through fidelity to the Church's liturgical texts and rites can we bring about an effective *Ars Celebrandi*, an art of celebrating the sacred liturgy with authenticity. (Continued from last week)

### THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER...continued

#### **#40 ~ What gestures are used by the concelebrants during the Eucharistic Prayer?**

In general, during the epiclesis the concelebrants extend their hands toward the offerings. At the words of the Lord, each extends his right hand "toward the bread and toward the chalice, if this seems appropriate; and at the elevation looking toward them and after this bowing profoundly." During the anamnesis they extend their hands in an orans gesture. Some variations to these rules are found in particular Eucharistic Prayers.

### THE COMMUNION RITE

#### **#41 ~ Can the priest use his own words for the introduction to the Lord's Prayer?**

The Priest's introduction to the Lord's prayer is not in "these or similar words." The Priest may use only the words provided in the Order of the Mass; "At the Savior's command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say:"

#### **#42 ~ Can the Lord's Prayer be sung in Latin?**

Notice that the Missal now provides the Lord's prayer in a sung setting in both English and Latin. This is clearly designed to encourage the occasional use of the Pater Noster.

#### **#43 ~ What parts of the extended Lord's Prayer are prayed by the priest?**

After the Priest and People pray the Lord's Prayer together, they enter into a dialogue:

Our Father.... Priest and People

"Deliver us Lord...." Priest alone

For the kingdom.... People alone

Lord, Jesus Christ Priest alone

Amen People alone

#### **#44 ~ To whom does the Priest offer a sign of peace?**

After the Priest has offered the peace to the whole congregation with the words "The Peace of the Lord be with you," everyone (the Priest included) offers a sign of peace to those standing nearby. "The Priest gives the sign of peace to a Deacon or minister," and he may, "for a reasonable cause...offer the Sign of Peace to a small number of the faithful"
