You can purchase your own **Choose Life License Plate** by either visiting your local registry of motor vehicles or on-line at: <https://secure.rmv.state.ma.us/SpecialPlates/intro.aspx>

*How Much Does It Cost?* The cost of the **Choose Life License Plate** is \$40 more than your regular registration fee. \$12 of that goes to pay for the manufacture of the plate. The remaining \$28 goes to the charity, Choose Life, Inc. When the plate is renewed, **the full \$40 goes to Choose Life, Inc.**

~ *The Choose Life License Plate is Pro-Woman, Pro-Baby, Pro-Family and Pro-Adoption!* The **Choose Life license plate** is fast approaching its two-year anniversary when the state will assess our plate. Currently, we are short of the required 3,000 plates. As a result, the state will hold our \$100,000 bond indefinitely.
