**PHYSICIAN ASSISTED SUICIDE IS SUICIDE...and suicide is always a tragedy.**

Massachusetts citizens will vote on “An Initiative Petition for An Act Relative to Death with Dignity” on November 6<sup>th</sup>. If passed, Physician Assisted Suicide would become legal in Massachusetts. Bishop Timothy McDonnell, along with the bishops of Massachusetts, are asking Catholics to stand against this initiative. The Catholic Church and all major religions have always taught that assisted suicide is wrong. The American Medical Association, The American College of Physicians and the Massachusetts Medical Society all oppose this measure. Advances in pain management allow doctors to ease the suffering of patients who are dying. The Bishops are asking Catholics to educate themselves and their families; to pray about the issue; and to visit and comfort the sick. And let us remember to words Blessed Pope John Paul II wrote in *Evangelium Vitae*: *“Causing death’ can never be considered a form of medical treatment, even when the intention is solely to comply with the patient’s request. Rather, it runs completely counter to the health-care profession, which is meant to be an impassioned and unflinching affirmation of life.”*
