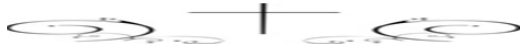

**PHYSICIAN ASSISTED SUICIDE IS SUICIDE...and suicide is always a tragedy.** Some people consider physician assisted suicide a merciful way to help those who are near death. This November, Massachusetts voters will have to decide if doctors should be able to legally give adult patients who are terminally ill, a lethal prescription to end their lives. But is this mercy? Consider the words of Blessed John Paul II from his 1995 encyclical, *Evangelium Vitae* or the Gospel of Life: “...*euthanasia must be called a false mercy, and indeed a disturbing ‘perversion’ of mercy. True ‘compassion’ leads to sharing another’s pain; it does not kill the person whose suffering we cannot bear.*” The bishops in Massachusetts are urging Catholics to stand by and stand up for those who are terminally ill and their families by providing support, compassion and care, and by showing them they are not walking alone.
