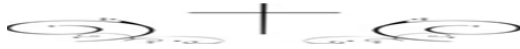

This speaker is well-versed on the content of the bill, and has presented at many functions. If passed on election day, physician-assisted suicide would become legal under Massachusetts law. No additional legislative or other approvals would be necessary. Therefore, it is critical that all voters be well-educated on this before casting their vote. Please join us in the parish hall, to learn what this bill includes, and what to expect if it passes. This is not a partisan issue but an issue that will affect all of us, Our parents, and our children. Following the presentation there will be time for questions and answers.
