**NO on 2      PHYSICIAN ASSISTED SUICIDE:**

On **Sunday, October 21**, Divine Mercy Parish, 2267 Main Street in Three Rivers, will be hosting a Communion breakfast followed by a guest speaker on the subject of Physician Assisted Suicide (Question 2, which will appear on the Massachusetts ballot on election day. This speaker is well-versed on the content of the bill, and has presented at many functions. If passed on election day, physician-assisted suicide would become legal under Massachusetts law. No additional legislative or other approvals would be necessary. Therefore, it is critical that all voters be well-educated on this before casting their vote. Please join us in the parish hall, to learn what this bill includes, and what to expect if it passes. This is not a partisan issue but an issue that will affect all of us, Our parents, and our children. Following the presentation there will be time for questions and answers. A breakfast will be served, at 10:30am for which tickets are available at the Church rectory, or by calling 662-9110 (leave a message) or emailing [sts.peterpaulanne@gmail.com](mailto:sts.peterpaulanne@gmail.com). Tickets ordered by phone or email can be picked up at the door. Additional chairs will be provided for anyone wishing to listen to the speaker, without participating in the breakfast. The Church hall is handicapped accessible. High school (and junior high) students are welcome, to learn more about this subject, which, if passed, will affect them, as well.
