## Does the Church Celebrate Halloween ??

Some of our holidays are also holy days...like Christmas, New Years, and Easter. Do you know if Halloween is a Holy Day, too?

October 31<sup>st</sup> isn't a Holy Day, but November 1<sup>st</sup> is All Saints Day (a Holy Day of Obligation) and November 2<sup>nd</sup> is All Soul's Day. Halloween was originally an Irish holiday, about 500 years before Jesus was born. October 31<sup>st</sup> was the official end of summer there, and the villagers believed, on that day, the spirits of those who had died during the year would roam the countryside searching for living bodies to possess for the next year. Not wanting to be "possessed", the people would dress up in scary costumes and make lots of noise parading around the streets, trying to frighten away the spirits.

As time passed, people no longer believed that the spirits were roaming, but still enjoyed dressing up like ghosts and witches. The Irish brought the custom of Halloween to American when they came to this country in the 1840's.

Trick-or-treating started in Europe, where, on All Soul's Day, early Christians would go from village to village begging for "soul cakes". The more soul cakes the beggars received, the more prayers they would say for the dead relatives of the people who gave them.

The Jack'o Lantern probably came from an Irish story of a man named Jack (a joker and trickster) who tricked the devil into climbing a tree. He then carved a cross in the tree's trunk, trapping the devil up there. He made a deal with the devil that, if he would never tempt him again, Jack would let him down. When Jack died, he couldn't go to heaven because of his evil ways, but he couldn't go to hell, either, because he had tricked the devil. Instead, the devil gave him a tiny ember to light his way through the darkness, and Jack put it in a turnip to keep it glowing longer. In America, pumpkins are more plentiful than turnips, so that's what we use today!
