Pro-Life News for June 9, 2013/ 4 MD Clinics Shut Down - ***Associates in OB.GYN Care*** had 3 of its Maryland clinics close in early March following the discovery by state inspectors that a woman died. Although the woman was said to have died from an underlying condition, Inspectors learned that the abortionist & staff were not certified in CPR, and a defibrillator at the clinic didn't work. After steps were taken to meet state standards, the abortion centers reopened on March 27. On May 24 they closed once again after inspectors discovered that all 4 clinics routinely administered Misoprostol to women who were past 11 weeks gestation even if the patient had not been evaluated by a physician & even if no physician was available on site. The state also discovered that an employee with no medical training had administered Misoprostol to induce an abortion & had performed an ultrasound on a woman who was 22 weeks pregnant. Patricia Nay of the Maryland Health Dept. said that the "public health, safety or welfare imperatively required emergency actions" against the clinics.

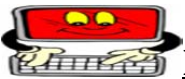

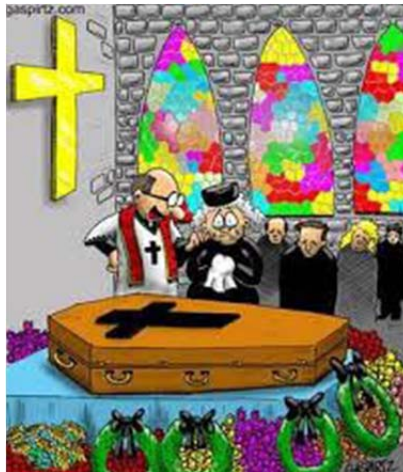
