**PRO-LIFE NEWS FOR AUGUST 18, 2013 / CLOSING OF CLINICS** ~ According to Mark Crutcher--Director of Life Dynamics, the number of Planned Parenthood Clinics in our country is declining rapidly. When he began his pro-life organization in 1992, there were 2,126 abortion mills in this country. Today, only 625 remain. What is causing these clinics to close is the passing of laws in states, requiring 2 things: (1) That a hospital no further than 30 miles away from the clinic will receive the abortionist's patients when necessary, and (2) That the abortion clinic abide by the same medical criteria as every other medical facility in this country. Ever since the 1973 Roe v. Wade decision, clinics have been virtually unsupervised. The abuses that have come to light lately (especially those at Gosnell's clinic in PA) have forced states to pass laws in an effort to protect women. This is indeed a blessing for women AND for unborn children!
