## <u>Divine Mercy Parish Council Meeting - September 17, 2013</u>

Minutes Opening Prayer: Led by Fr. Stefan

**Attendance**: 11 Present (Fr. Stefan, Diane Baldyga, Barbara Kelleher, Tom Losaw, Carol Mastalerz, Sally Mastalerz, Lydia McKee, Victoria Miner, Fred Orszulak, Luke Roberts, John Yurkunas); 4 absent (Mark MacDougall, Donna Olearczyk, Tom Schultz, Todd Smola) 4 excused (Margaret Brozek, John Fox, Dick Kelleher, Joseph Brozek) Father noted that we couldn't vote for a new President, because we didn't have a quorum. We will vote at our next meeting. There were no minutes from the previous meeting.

**OLD BUSINESS:** There was no old business.

**NEW BUSINESS**: Father received an offer, through the diocese, for St. Anne Church and grounds. The offer is substantially lower than the listed price of \$550,000, but Father explained the costs to the diocese of keeping the property (which may ultimately end up being a cost to our parish, if the diocese withholds the amount spent on St. Anne's from the purchase price at the time of sale, before turning the funds over to Divine Mercy Parish. Father explained that, since the building is no longer being used as a church (or rectory, or school), the town is taxing the property at the commercial tax rate. Also, insurance on the properties must be maintained, and that, too, is extremely high. Grounds must be maintained, at a cost to our parish, and the building's condition is declining more with each passing year. It would become 'unsalable' in coming years. The offer is for \$275,000, and Father asked the Council to vote on whether or not to accept it. A vote was taken, and it was agreed, unanimously, to sell it. The potential buyer is a Christian (non-denominational) Church from Palmer, that is currently meeting in the old Grange Hall. Father will sign the papers on September 18, and return them to the diocese. He will include the words "sold as is" in the acceptance.

- ~~ Father welcomed, on behalf of the entire Council, the newest members -- Sally Mastalerz, Victoria Miner, Tom Losaw, Margaret Brozek and John Fox.
- ~~Father told the Council that Debbie Ingalls, one of our parish secretaries for the past four years, is leaving her position (which she had accepted as a temporary job all those years ago) She has done an excellent job with the bulletin, and handling the phones and much more for Father. That position will not be filled. Debbie will be greatly missed!
- ~~A suggestion was made to make a banner, to be displayed in Church, with the names of our active duty military personnel who are parish members, or close relatives to parishioners. Recognizing the power of prayer, the banner would serve as a reminder to all of us to keep them in our prayers, as they serve our country 'in harm's way'. A notice will be put in the bulletin requesting parishioners to supply us with their names, so they can be included on our banner. Father said there is much talent in our parish, as far as fashioning the banner. If someone would like to volunteer for this project, please let the rectory know. (We would like the banner to be a proper tribute to these individuals who are sacrificing much.)
- ~~A discussion was held on the cemeteries.
- ~~Father reported that the CCD program is working well, on Saturdays and Sunday mornings. ~~Closing prayer was led by Father Stefan.
