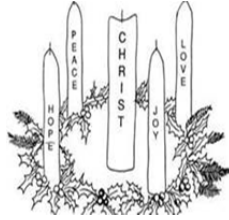

**BELCHERTOWN HIGH SCHOOL TRUMPET PLAYER JOSEPH BROZEK** recognized for earning spot on All-National Honor Concert Band. Joe 16, has been honored by the school board as the first Belchertown student to earn – via his audition -- a place in the All-National Honor Concert Band. Brozek successfully auditioned for the National Association for Music Education sponsored band that selected 670 of the country's top high school musicians. In addition to the band, the music educator's association also sponsored a chorus, an orchestra and a jazz ensemble. The groups performed at a gala concert Oct. 30 in Nashville at the Gaylord Opryland Hotel. "The whole experience was unforgettable," Joe told the school board. "I played with some of the best musicians in the country." Joseph's father Paul, also a trumpet player, has been Joseph's only music teacher. "It is pretty cool to have someone in the house" teaching me, the high school junior said. Joseph said he practices between 45 minutes and two hours each day. On weekends, he performs with the Springfield Youth Orchestra under the direction of Jonathan Lam. As a freshman and sophomore, Joe has performed in the Quabbin Valley Music Educators' Association Concert Band, the Western Massachusetts Music Educators' Association Orchestra and Concert Band, and Massachusetts Music Educators' All-State Festival Orchestra and Concert Band.
