PRO-LIFE NEWS FOR JUNE 29 - It is totally illegal for a mother to abort her child in El Salvador, the smallest country in Central America. Julia Cardenal, president of Si a la Vida (Yes to Life Foundation), said that "it was a miracle". Pro-lifers knew that receiving foreign aid to help improve their country usually comes with "reproductive rights" attached. The only way to guarantee protection for the unborn was to pass a constitutional amendment that no treaty could override. Half of the country's legislators favored the amendment, but a two-thirds majority was needed. Pro-lifers immediately called for a national prayer campaign. When the time came for a vote, a socialist woman spoke out & said, "I'm going to give my vote as a woman & as a medical doctor **FOR** the constitutional amendment." After that, there was no vote against it. Praise God and **never** cease praying!
