This is a series model pipe organ of electro-pneumatic action; there are twenty-two ranks of pipes. The compass of the manuals is 56 notes; that of the pédalier, 32 notes. The organ was installed in the Church in April 1977 by M. Roland Bonneau of Casavant with the assistance of Messrs. Czelusniak et Dugal of Southampton, who served also as consultants to the Church in the design of and preparation for the new instrument. Mr. Henry Hokans of Worcester was the representative for Casavant. Mrs. Mary Besko is the Music Director of the Parish. The new organ will be under the care of Messrs. Czelusniak et Dugal. The supporting casework was constructed by Mr. John Wysocki of Westfield, Massachusetts.
